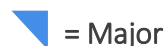
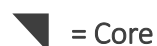

To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed a total of 400 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Core - 250 units (comprising of 170 units of Laws and 80 units of Social Science).
- ✓ Social Science Major - 80 units.
- ✓ Directed LAWS 5000 level Courses - 70 units. Refer to the [Program Handbook](#) for a current a current list of courses available and up to date information.
- ✓ The duration of this program is 5 years full time study (40 units per semester) or part time equivalent.
- ✓ The maximum time to complete is 8 years.
- ✓ Credit will not normally be granted in LAWS courses totalling more than 80 units. Where the course or courses passed at another university or approved tertiary institution do not correspond in content with any course in the list of Approved Courses for the LLB (Honours), unspecified credit will not be granted in more than 40 units.

3. 40 units of 3000 level courses for your Major, including 20 units of 3000 level Compulsory courses in each Major.
