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# BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (SECONDARY)

To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 330 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- Please also refer to further information found at [B Education \(Secondary\) - Majors](#).
- Core courses (including Professional Placement) – 150 units
- One Humanities Major (First Teaching Area) - 80 units; and
- One Additional Teaching Area - 60 unit; and a choice of one of the following:
  - TESOL - 40 units; or
  - Special Education - 40 units; or
  - Electives - 40 units.
- Shared compulsory courses: If your Major (First Teaching Area) and Additional Teaching Area have overlapping Compulsory courses, you can undertake an additional Elective in this place. Students can use Electives to meet a Second Additional Teaching Area where the Additional Teaching Area shares Compulsory courses with one of student's First or Second Teaching Areas.
- Some Majors and Additional Teaching Areas are available at both Callaghan and Ourimbah where others are available only at Callaghan. Please visit the Program Handbook to confirm Major/Additional Teaching Area locations.
- If students wish to take Mathematics courses, please review the information at [Enrolling in Maths](#) to determine which course will complement your previous knowledge.
- Students will need to ensure that they meet the registration requirements for all of their teaching areas.
- Students must complete a minimum of 40 units at all levels (1000, 2000, 3000 and 4000), and can complete a maximum of 120 units at 1000 level.
- The duration of this program is 4 years full time study (40 units per semester) or part time equivalent.
- The maximum time to complete this program is 10 years.
- Graded Honours is available in the Bachelor of Education (Secondary) (Honours) program, for those students who meet the eligibility requirements. Students have the option of transferring after the completion of 160 units in Bachelor of Education (Secondary). 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# BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (SECONDARY)

### Major/Additional Teaching Area sequences

A Major or Additional Teaching Area (ATA) is an area of study that you wish to focus on in your program. A course will count towards your Major or Additional teaching area if it is listed as a Compulsory or Directed course under the relevant Major in the Program Handbook. You must complete 80 units in your Major, and 60 units in your Additional teaching area. Students can use Electives to meet a Second Additional teaching area where the Additional teaching area shares Compulsory courses. To meet the requirements of the Major sequence please refer to the Program Handbook for the specific rules for each specialisation.

Teacher	Registration requirements
English teacher	Students must enrol in at least 30 units of literature. Additional units may be taken in creative writing, film or other literature.
Drama teacher	Students must ensure course choices cover performance, production, theory and preferably Australian Drama.
Modern History teacher	Students must enrol in at 10 units of Ancient History.
Ancient History teacher	Students must enrol in 10 units of Modern History.
Studies of Religion teacher	Students should enrol in no more than 20 units in any one religious tradition, and should not complete more than 10 units of AHIS courses (ancient religious history or traditions)
