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To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 160 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- Core courses – 130 units
- Electives – 30 units (with no more than 20 units at the 3000 level), visit the Program Handbook to access a list of recommended Electives, or choose from the Course Handbook to add subject content knowledge in a specific teaching area.
- Students should seek advice from the Program Convenor if completing Electives to meet the NESA Subject Content Knowledge (SCK) requirements of specific teaching area(s). Program Convenor approval is required to complete Electives at the 1000 or 2000 level to meet SCK requirements only. Please note electives completed to satisfy SCK requirements may need to be completed in study terms other than those indicated on the plan, e.g. Semester.
- Students must only complete courses that form part of the program.
- The duration of this program is 1.5 years (4 trimesters) full-time (40 units per trimester) or part-time equivalent.
- The maximum time to complete this program is 6 years.
