To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 320 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- **Core courses** – 160 units (completed at the University of Newcastle)

** PHYS courses. Students choose to undertake PHYS1210 Advanced Physics 1 in lieu of PHYS1205 with Program Convenor approval.

- Years 3 and 4 completed at either the University of New South Wales or University of Wollongong.
- The duration of this program is 4 years full-time (40 units per semester) or part-time equivalent.
- The maximum time to complete this program is 10 years.
