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MASTER OF SPECIAL AND INCLUSIVE EDUCATION

To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 80 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- Core courses – 30 units.
- Students must complete 80 units of study consisting of a combination of three Core courses, specialisation Compulsory courses and Directed courses. This varies according to the selected specialisation. Visit the [Program Handbook](#) for more information.
- Victorian Department of Education and Training Scholarship recipients **MUST** complete [EDUC6109](#) (General Special Education, Early Childhood or Emotional Disturbance/Behaviour Problems specialisations) or [EDUC6056](#) (Deaf Studies Deaf Education specialisation) as a compulsory course in their program of study. This is a condition of your Scholarship.
- The maximum time to complete this program is specified in your scholarship agreement with the Victorian Department of Education.
- The duration of this program is one year full-time (40 units per semester) or part-time equivalent.
- Part-time students generally enrol in 10–20 units each Semester (2-4 years duration).
