To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 400 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Core courses - 210 units
- ✓ Major 1 - 80 units (including compulsory courses).
- ✓ Directed courses - 80 units. Refer to the [Program Handbook](#) for a list of current courses available and up to date information.
- ✓ Electives - 30 units. Visit the [Course Handbook](#) to see a list of available Electives.
- ✓ Students must complete a minimum of 40 units at all levels (1000, 2000, and 3000), and can complete a maximum of 100 units at 1000 level.
- ✓ The duration of this program is 3 years full time study (40 units per semester) or part time equivalent.
- ✓ The maximum time to complete this program is 8 years.
