Eligibility: Applications for financial assistance will only be considered for students who:

- Are currently enrolled
- Completed at least one semester of study
- Are in good academic standing
- Do not have any outstanding debts owed to The University of Newcastle
- Demonstrate genuine financial hardship where continued study might be placed in jeopardy
- Loans - demonstrate their ability to meet the required loan repayments
- Loans - ensure that a loan will not put them in further financial difficulty

Student Loans – Domestic Students and International Students

Student loans are interest-free loans that are available on a short term basis to students who demonstrate genuine need and whose continued study might be placed in jeopardy without additional assistance.

Student Hardship Grants – Domestic Students Only

Student Hardship Grants are available for students experiencing extreme financial hardship. Hardship Grants are provided to help with accommodation costs, basic living costs (including medical), textbook and course material/equipment costs and transport costs.

Student Placement Grants – Domestic Students Only

Student Placement Grants are available for those required to complete a practical component as part of their degree. These grants are provided to cover costs directly associated with placements. Students may be granted \$300, \$500 or \$750. This may also include grocery and/or petrol vouchers.

Important: Placement Grants will not be issued to cover loss of wages while students are on placement.

To apply for financial assistance, please email or hand deliver your completed documentation to the Student Loans and Welfare Advisor. Once the documentation is returned, the Student Loans and Welfare advisor will contact you if – a meeting is required or more documentation is needed or inform you of the outcome of your application.

Please apply by providing the following:

- A completed copy of the Student Financial Assistance Application Form
- Two forms of ID including your UON Student Card
- Current Bank Statement (all accounts you hold, full month of transactions)
- Centrelink/Income Statement and/or 3 x payslips or payment advice from employers
- Valid evidence of costs (bills, rent receipts, housing bonds, textbook quote etc. - we cannot provide funds without valid evidence of costs)

For Placement grants please also provide the following:

- Evidence of placement (print out of SONIA or placement letter)
- Placement accommodation costs/quotes
- Estimate of transport costs
- Other placement related costs i.e. uniform, certificates

Please be reminded that if you are approved for a Student Loan or Grant there is a minimum waiting period of 7 to 10 days from the date of approval before the funds will be dispersed to your nominated financial institution. Applications are assessed 2 days per week, while we understand that your application may be of an urgent nature, unfortunately this timeframe is not negotiable.
