To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 80 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- Core courses – 40 units (20 units studied at Callaghan, NURS6900 and MIDI6520. 20 units studied Online, MIDI6580 and MIDI6591)
- Directed courses – 40 units (20 studied at Callaghan, NURS6623, NURS6910. 20 units of general directed courses studied at Callaghan and/or Newcastle City). Visit the [Program Handbook](#) for more information.
- The approximate duration of this program is 1 year full-time study
- The intake for this program for on-campus international students is Trimester 1, 2 and 3.
- The above enrolment pattern complies with the conditions of international student visas. The above enrolment guide is the recommended pattern for international on-campus students only.
- The maximum time to complete this program is 4 years.
