- The duration of this program is 1 year full-time (40 units per semester) or part-time equivalent.

If you are planning to enrol in the Bachelor of Construction Management (Building)(Honours) you should complete the Building Major.

If you are planning to enrol in the Bachelor of Design (Architecture) you should complete the Design Major.
