Depending on your country of citizenship, you may be eligible for, Undergraduate programs, Master by Coursework, Master by Research, Doctor of Philosophy and Technical and vocational qualifications. Applicants must align their proposed program with their country's approved priority sectors.

Applications close on 30 April 2026 at 2.00 pm AEST.
