

To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 320 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Core courses (including Professional Placement) 250 units.
- Compulsory courses 10 units.
- ✓ Minor courses 60 units.
- ✓ Students must not exceed 100 units at any level (1000, 2000, 3000, or 4000).
- All students who complete the requirements of the program will be eligible for Ungraded Honours. High performing students who meet the eligibility requirements will be able to complete Graded Honours. Please see the Bachelor of Teaching (Fine Art) (Honours) No Minor Program Plan for information about the requirements to complete Graded Honours or Ungraded Honours with no Minor within the program.
- ✓ The duration of this program is 4 years full time study (40 units per semester) or part time equivalent.
- The maximum time to complete this program is 10 years.



Some courses have assumed knowledge and/or requisites, please refer to the individual <u>Course Handbook</u>. The <u>Program Handbook</u> has valuable information on program structure and requirements, if you are intending on studying part time or varying from this program plan please seek prior advice from your Program Advisor.
