BACHELOR OF MEDICAL SCIENCE AND DOCTOR OF MEDICINE (MD-JMP)

To be eligible to graduate you must have completed 480 units (including 80 units of credit in the Doctor of Medicine) which meet the following criteria:

- The Bachelor of Medical Science and Doctor of Medicine programs are undertaken sequentially over 5 years of full-time study (40 units per semester)
- Bachelor of Medical Science – 240 units of core courses
- Doctor of Medicine - 160 units of core courses and 80 units of credit
- Years 1 - 3 = Bachelor of Medical Science and Years 4 – 5 = Doctor of Medicine
- Students enrol on a semester basis with the delivery of the academic content occurring across the full year

- This program contains clinical/professional placements. Students must meet [NSW Health Verification Requirements](#) and obtain a WorkCover approved First Aid Certificate.
- The maximum time to complete this program is 8 years.
