

# **PUBH6305 Global Health Systems & Policy**

## **One Week Intensive Workshop**

This Course is offered for those students with an interest in acquiring knowledge and skills in Health Systems and Health Policy. The course will cover health systems and health policy to equip students with a conceptual understanding and a set of tools to address major public health challenges from a health systems and health policy perspective. The unit will provide an understanding of health systems including specific topics such as health workforce, financing, service delivery, information systems as well as health policy, and how these impact health interventions and health outcomes in countries. A case study approach will provide students with concrete examples of health systems and policy challenges, as well as the opportunity to critique the approach to health services provision in their own setting.

### **Mode of Delivery**

The course will be offered in both:

1. **Face to face mode** (see One Week Intensive Workshop outline below) and
2. **Distance mode**, via Blackboard, with ongoing facilitation throughout Semester 2 as per the usual distance mode of delivery via Gradschool.

Those students who enrol to take this course by distance mode, are welcome to also attend the One Week Intensive Workshop in Newcastle. There will be no face to face weekly tutorial / lecture for this course during Semester 2. All face to face teaching for this course will take place in the One Week Intensive Workshop.
