ACTIVE TRAVEL

Ride, walk, skate – active travel options are some of the most efficient and effective ways to incorporate regular exercise into our daily lives and reduce our carbon footprint. Modern end-of-trip facilities are located in two Bike Hubs with showers, lockers and secure bike storage. PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Buses, trains and ferries service the CBD and Callaghan and you can plan your trip using the Newcastle Transport website.

Opal Cards, accepted on both buses and trains, are the most convenient and cost effective way to travel by public transport.

We have two major bus stops on campus, the Maths and Design bus stops as well as a train station at Warabrook. Once you're on campus, getting around is easy using the free UON security shuttle bus. Just download the DoubleMap app to see where the bus is in real time and head to your nearest clearly signposted shuttle bus stop.

PARK AND RIDE (EXPRESS SHUTTLE SERVICE)

If you live in the city you can catch the free express shuttle bus from the bus stop on King Street, across from University House to Callaghan campus. Our express shuttle service runs weekdays from the city to Callaghan campus and starts at 7:15am, concluding with the last bus leaving Callaghan at 10:15pm.

During semester teaching periods, including exam times, the shuttle service runs every 30min. There are two drop off points on Callaghan, one near car park 14 (accommodation precinct) and one at the Design bus stop. To board the bus you will need to use your staff or student ID.

If you're heading to the city you can park your car at Callaghan in the designated Park and Ride car parks and catch the free express shuttle service.

RIDE SHARE

Ridesharing is a smarter way to get to campus. You can save money, share your drive, meet new friends and reduce your carbon footprint while travelling to campus.

The UON exclusive Liftango app aims to match riders with drivers to make Ridesharing easy. Within the Callaghan campus there are over 50 dedicated Rideshare bays conveniently located in various car parks across the campus. To access these car parks you need to use the free Liftango app and display a staff or student parking permit, or buy a car park ticket.

The app is free to download and free to use. Find the Liftango app at the App Store or Google Play.

DRIVE AND PARK

If you need to drive to campus, there are over 2800 general car parking bays and over 1000 staff parking bays located in car parks across campus. The whole campus is termed a Restricted Area which means you will need a paid parking permit or a daily paid ticket purchased from the ticket machines to park on campus.

To avoid a costly fine, please read the signs and adhere to the on road markings to ensure you are parking in the correct area. Also avoid parking on the grassed areas or footpaths. From most car parks, you can use the free UON security shuttle bus to get around campus. Just download the DoubleMap app to see where the bus is in real time and head to your nearest clearly signposted shuttle bus stop.
