INTERNATIONAL WORK PLACEMENT – SUMMER/WINTER 2024/25

Are you interested in undertaking a cultural immersion and work-integrated learning opportunity in Vietnam?

The Newcastle Business School is inviting students to apply for a cultural immersion and work-integrated learning opportunity in Ho Chi Minh City, the largest financial centre in Vietnam. During the four-week internship students will be placed with a local company through Abroader, a trusted overseas internship provider. The Abroader Program includes accommodation, multicultural and communication skills training, a local buddy to show you around the city, networking opportunities, and 24/7 support.

The internship will be credited through BUSN3500 International Work Placement (Summer/Winter term, 2024/25). You will be placed in an international company with an English-speaking supervisor; however you are encouraged to learn some of the local language as well to boost your confidence and respect in the workplace.

ELIGIBILITY

Units Requirement: Students must have completed 120 units of study to be eligible for BUSN3500.

Health and Safety: A self-assessment must be completed as part of the application process to determine fitness for travel. If necessary a medical examination may be required.

Passport Validity: Students must have a passport valid for at least six months beyond the date of their return (i.e., until at least June 2025).

Application Deadline: At least 2 months prior to your desired start date.

Flights and Visa: It is up to the student to organise their own flights once their internship is approved through NBS and through Abroader.

FINANCES

The 4-week Internship Program with Abroader is \$4,673 AUD inclusive of accommodation and networking events.

Australian students also access an OS-HELP loan of up to \$9,504 once approved.

International students must pay out of pocket in full.

Students will be enrolled in BUSN3500 and therefore also pay tuition fees for this course.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. Initial Application: Login to SONIA here. Go to the FORMS tab and ADD+ the "International Placement Application" form from the drop-down box. Click EDIT to open the form and complete the required fields.
- **2. Abroader Application:** Apply directly to <u>Abroader</u> for programs in 2025.
- **3. Course Enrolment:** Enrol in BUSN3500 via MyHub.
- 4. Pre-Departure Requirements:
 - Complete the online Pre-Departure
 Module on the BUSN3500 Canvas site.
 - Attend two weeks of compulsory, 2hour pre-departure sessions with your course coordinator on campus.
