






Event Recording
Music captured at the same time as video footage




AV Production
Music added separately, not captured at the same time as footage


Source of the music



Live music/lyrics
e.g., song recorded while performed



Sound recording
e.g., Taylor Swift played at an event




Live music/lyrics
e.g., live singer used over campus footage




Sound recording
e.g., Taylor Swift edited into video
