To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 320 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Core courses (including Professional Placement) 250 units.
- ✓ Compulsory 30 units (Ungraded Honours) or 60 units (Graded Honours).
- ✓ Directed courses 20 units (Ungraded Honours) or 10 units (Graded Honours).
- ✓ Electives 20 units (Ungraded Honours only). Visit the <u>Course Handbook</u> to see a list of available Electives.
- ✓ Students must not exceed 100 units at any level (1000, 2000, 3000 or 4000).
- ✓ All students who complete the requirements of the program will be eligible for Ungraded Honours. High performing students who meet the eligibility requirements will be able to complete Graded Honours.
- ✓ The duration of this program is 4 years full time study (40 units per semester) or part time equivalent.
- ✓ The maximum time to complete this program is 10 years.
