# BACHELOR OF ORAL HEALTH THERAPY

To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 240 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- Core courses – 230 units
- Electives – 10 units, visit the [Course Handbook](#) for more information
- It is also a requirement that students complete clinical/professional placements. Students must meet [NSW Health Verification Requirements](#) and obtain a WorkCover approved First Aid Certificate.
- The duration of this program is 3 years full-time (students must undertake 40 units per semester).
- The maximum time to complete this program is 5 years.
