To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 320 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Core courses – 190 units, including:
  - Core Arts – 30 units
  - Core Innovation & Entrepreneurship – 160 units;**and one of the following:**
- ✓ Single Major and Single Minor:
  - Arts Major – 80 units (including all Compulsory courses and the required number of Directed courses for one Major sequence); and
  - Arts Minor – 40 units (including all Compulsory courses and the required number of Directed courses for one Minor sequence); and
  - Electives – 10 units. Visit the [Course Handbook](#) to see a list of available Electives.**or**
- ✓ Single Major:
  - Arts Major – 80 units (including all Compulsory courses and the required number of Directed courses for one Major sequence); **and**
  - Electives – 50 units;
- ✓ Students must complete a minimum of 40 units at all levels (1000, 2000, and 3000), and can complete a maximum of 120 units at 1000 level.
- ✓ Students who perform well during the program with a credit average (GPA of 5.0) or greater, may apply for a further year of full time (or equivalent part time) study to obtain an Honours degree.
- ✓ The duration of this program is 4 years full time (40 units per semester) or part time equivalent.
- ✓ The maximum time to complete this program is 10 years.
