To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 80 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- Core courses – 30 units
- Specialisation courses – complete 30 units of Specialisation courses from the relevant specialisation list.
- General Directed courses – All specialisations to complete 20 units, visit the [Program Handbook](#) for more information. Students who complete no specialisation need to complete 50 units of General Directed courses.
- The approximate duration of this program is 1 year full-time study or part-time equivalent
- The maximum time to complete this program is 4 years.
- The above enrolment pattern is a recommended pattern only. Students who are working whilst studying would typically complete 10-20 units per term.
- CLAM courses are only offered every second year.
