There are changes to the program in 2023.

The **Film, Media and Cultural Studies Major** is discontinued and replaced by the **Screen and Cultural Studies Major**.

Students who graduate from the program in **2022** and who are undertaking the **Film, Media and Cultural Studies Major** will graduate with this Major.

Students who are continuing in the program in **2023** and who are undertaking the Film, Media and Cultural Studies Major will be transferred to the **Screen and Cultural Studies Major**.

Reflecting this change, several course codes and course titles have also been updated. The following table displays a summary of the approved course equivalency arrangements for students who commenced in the Bachelor of Global Indigenous Studies [40122] prior to 2023.

Screen and Cultural Studies (SCRN) courses replace the equivalent Film, Media and Cultural Studies (FMCS) courses from 2023 onwards. Courses completed prior to 2023 (FMCS courses) will continue to count towards program requirements.
