INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS WHO COMMENCED IN THE BACHELOR OF DEVELOPMENT STUDIES [11368] PRIOR TO 2023

The University is incorporating Work Integrated Learning (WIL) into all undergraduate programs as a 10-unit Core Course (ENVS3008 – Work Integrated Learning in the Environmental and Development Sectors). WIL provides students from all disciplines and backgrounds with the opportunity to gain real world work experience and improve employability outcomes. ENVS3008 has been revised to increase the placement hours from 80 to 140 hours for students commencing in the program from 2023 onwards.

Transition Arrangements

Students who commenced the program prior to 2023 will have the opportunity to complete the revised ENVS3008 as part of their major.
