INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS WHO COMMENCED IN THE BACHELOR OF PYSCHOLOGICAL SCIENCE/BACHELOR OF SOCIAL SCIENCE [40291] PRIOR TO 2023

The University is incorporating Work Integrated Learning (WIL) into all undergraduate programs as a 10-unit WIL Directed course (PSYC3002 – Work Integrated Learning in Psychology or SOCS3300 – Criminal Justice Placement), for students commencing in the program from 2023 onwards. WIL provides students from all disciplines and backgrounds with the opportunity to gain real world work experience and improve employability outcomes.

Transition Arrangements

SOCS2100 – Organisational Management and Social Behaviour has been discontinued.

Students who commenced the program prior to 2023 and have successfully completed SOCS2100 and all Sociology and Anthropology Directed courses (for students in this major) will not be required to undertake WIL.

For pre-2023 students in the Sociology and Anthropology major, who have successfully completed SOCS2100 but **haven't** completed all the major's Directed courses, SOCS2100 will be changed from Core to count toward your major's Directed requirements, and you **will be** required to complete either WIL Directed course SOCS3300 or PSYC3002.

Pre-2023 students who **are not** completing the Sociology and Anthropology major and are yet to successfully complete SOCS2100, **will be** required to complete either WIL Directed course SOCS3300 or PSYC3002 instead of SOCS2100.
