

# BUSN3500 INTERNATIONAL WORK PLACEMENT –

## Are you interested in undertaking a cultural immersion and work-integrated learning opportunity in Africa?

The Newcastle Business School is inviting students to apply for a cultural immersion and work-integrated learning opportunities in Cape Town and discover the country's natural beauty, excellent surfing, incredible 'Big 5' wildlife, and diversity of culture and ethnic groups. During the four-week internship students will be placed with a local company through Intern Abroad HQ, a trusted overseas internship provider. The Intern Abroad HQ Program includes accommodation, networking events, cultural events, an Experiential Learning Curriculum and 24/7 on-the-ground support. The internship will be credited through BUSN3500 International Work Placement (Summer Winter, 2024/2025.

These internships are conducted in English.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

- Units Requirement: Students must have completed 120 units of study to be eligible for BUSN3500.
- Health and Safety: A self-assessment must be completed as part of the application process to determine fitness for travel. If necessary a medical examination may be required.
- Passport Validity: Students must have a passport valid for at least six months beyond the date of their return (i.e., until at least June 2025).
- Application Deadline: Please start Step 1 ASAP. Step 2 must be completed 2 months prior to your desired start date.
- Flights and Visa: It is up to the student to organise their own flights and visa once their internship is approved through NBS and through Intern Abroad HQ.

#### **FINANCES**

The Intern Abroad HQ cost is \$2,184 USD for the 4-week program. It is inclusive of accommodation, training and networking events.

Eligible domestic Australian students may access an OS-HELP loan of up to \$9,504 once approved. International students must pay out of pocket in full.

Students will be enrolled in BUSN3500 and therefore also pay tuition fees for this course.

#### **HOW TO APPLY**

- 1. Initial Application: Login to SONIA here. Go to the FORMS tab and ADD+ the "International Placement Application" form from the drop-down box. Click EDIT to open the form and complete the required fields.
- 2. IAHQ Application: Apply directly to <a href="Intern">Intern</a>
  Abroad HQ
- **3. Course Enrolment:** Enrol in BUSN3500 via MyHub once you have received approval from step 1 and 2.
- 4. Pre-Departure Requirements:
  - Complete the online Pre-Departure
     Module on the BUSN3500 Canvas site.
  - Attend two weeks of compulsory, 2-hour pre-departure sessions with your course coordinator on campus.
