- Much more than Lecture Capture (Replacing Echo360)
 - **Capture content**
 - All timetabled 'Lectures' will still be automatically scheduled for capture* and transferred to Bb site (Policy requirement)
 - Staff can continue to 'opt-in' for recordings in equipped venues
 - Create desktop recordings (now available via Software Centre)
 - Embed recordings in content areas of Bb sites
 - **Video management**
 - Searchable, secure portal
 - Allows you to upload/manage/share videos
- In-room recording technology updates
- Full roll-out : Trimester 1, 2019 (*pending project timelines*)

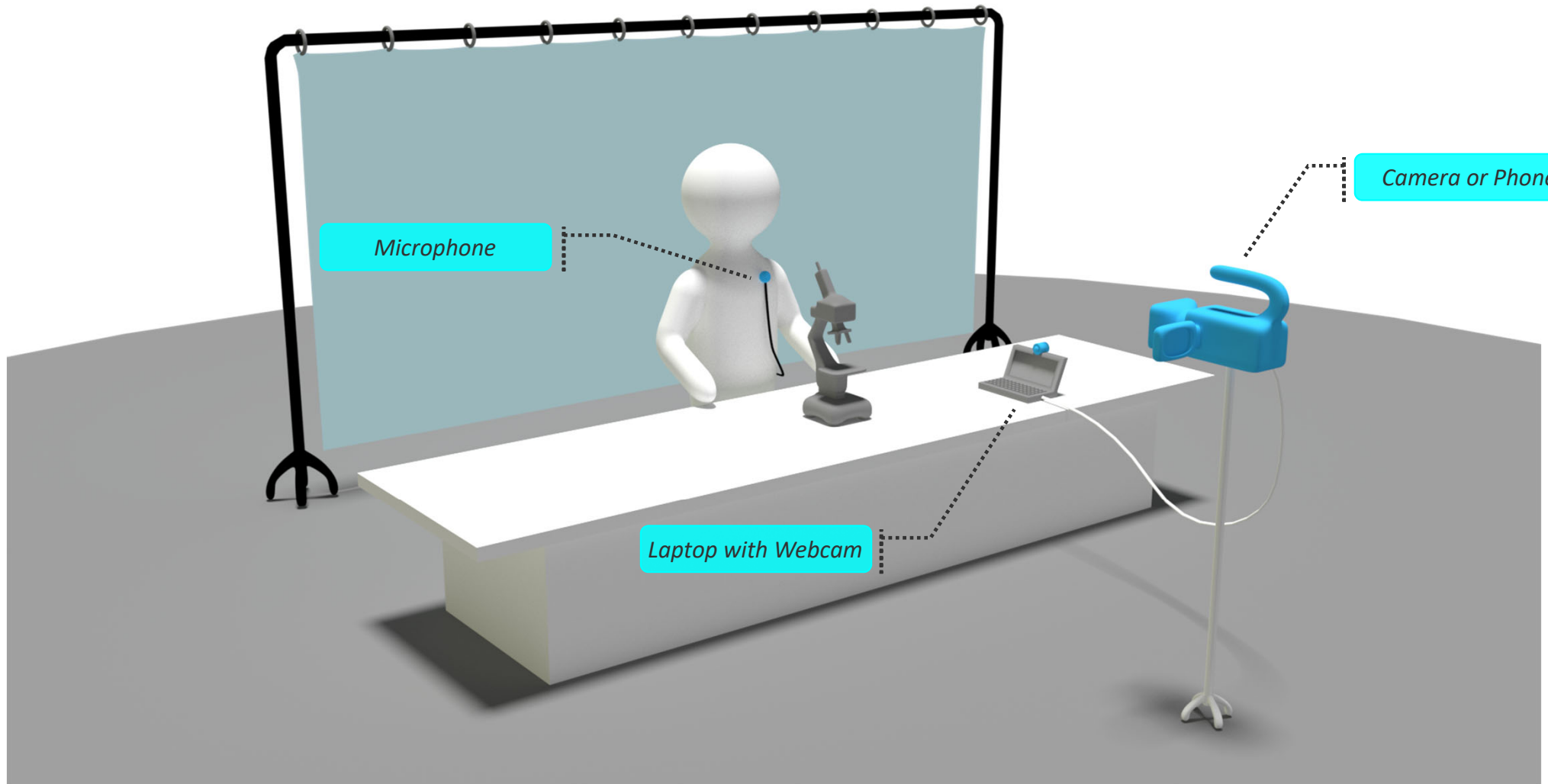
