THE CHRISTIAN REMEMBRANCER

The Centre has an on-going project of looking at authorship in the *Christian Remembrancer* from the time in 1844 when the editorship was assumed by the Rev. J.B. Mozley and the Rev. William Scott and the journal became a quarterly instead of a monthly. We have managed to find documentary evidence for a number of these articles in memoirs and unpublished correspondence with publishers, and these are noted below. Our major work, however, has been an attempt to identify by statistical analysis articles written by the literary journalist Anne Mozley who contributed substantially to the *Saturday Review* and *Blackwood's* during the period 1860 to 1880. It is known that she began contributing to the *Christian Remembrancer* much earlier than this, and we believe that our statistical tests have identified eleven articles she contributed between 1847, for two of which there is some external confirmation.
