- Directed courses – 30 units. These can be undertaken in Semesters and/or Trimesters
- The duration of this program is 2 years part time
- The maximum time to complete this program is 6 years
- It is recommended that students enrol as per the above plan any variation should be discussed with the Program Convenor to avoid issues relating to course availability
- Students who are working whilst studying would typically complete 10-20 units per term
