- ✓ **Core courses** – 50 units; and **one** of the following 4 options:
 - **Single Major Pathway A** – Major - 80 units and Minor - 40 units and Electives – 70 units; **or**
 - **Single Major Pathway B** – Major - 80 units and Minor 1 - 40 units and Minor 2 - 40 units and Electives – 30 units; **or**
 - **Single Major Pathway C** – Major - 80 units and Electives – 110 units; **or**
 - **Double Major Pathway** – Major 1 - 80 units and Major 2 - 80 units and Electives – 30 units.

- ✓ Students must complete a minimum of 40 units at all levels (1000, 2000, and 3000), and can complete a maximum of 100 units at 1000 level.
