

DIPLOMA IN BUILT ENVIRONMENT

Completing the Diploma in Built Environment lets you receive up to:

80 units of credit into the Bachelor of Construction Management (Building) (Honours)

60 units of credit into the Bachelor of Design (Architecture)

Whether you can receive the full amount of credit will depend on which major you complete in the Diploma in Built Environment and which Bachelor degree program you choose. Please refer to the information below to make sure you choose the right major to maximise your credit into your chosen Bachelor degree program.
