

# How to plan a Short Course

**1** Find a copy of your program plan for your degree.

**2** Think about what break\* you want to study in.

**3** Decide if you will be arranging credit towards a core, directed or elective course. We highly recommend using an elective!

Fun fact: you can move an elective to any summer or winter term.

**4** Find a course you'd like to complete. You can search by country, study area, previously credited courses, or even find your own!

**5** Submit your application to Global Experience via the careerhub portal.

## Things to consider when choosing a course:

> How do you pay the tuition fees? Does payment go to UON, the host uni, or to the third party provider?

>Accommodation during the course: is there on-campus, nearby or do you need to find your own?

>Excursions / social program - does the university or provider organise activities?

>Overall cost including flights, accommodation, transport, meals etc. Are there scholarships or loans available?

\*If you wish to take out the OS-Help loan, you'll need to have 80 units on your transcript.
