Credit Card Surcharge Fees

From 4 March 2024, for any payments made to tuition fees and other non-tuition charges using a debit or credit card, a surcharge fee will apply.

The introduction of surcharge will help to support the long-term financial sustainability of the University by recouping or reducing costs associated with credit card fees.

The University seeks to minimise fees incured by students and customers wherever possible and ensures fee-free options are available.
