<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Some courses *are offered in both the DIRECTED and MAJOR course lists. You can count these courses towards your directed OR your major: you CANNOT count them toward BOTH. Many politics POLI courses run at both 2nd and 3rd year level (same course, different assessment). In the majors you can take these courses either at the 2nd or the 3rd year level - whichever works best for you. To finish in three years you need to take 40 units per semester Not all courses are offered every year. Please follow the PEC that covers the year in which you first enrolled.
