To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 80 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- Core courses – 30 units
- Specialisation Compulsory and/or Directed courses – 50 units visit the [Program Handbook](#) for more information
- The duration of this program is 1 year full time study or part time equivalent.
- The maximum time to complete this program is 4 years.
- Program is offered by distance learning online
- Completion of a compulsory three-day on campus workshop is also required for students enrolled in the Trauma, Surgery, Military and Orthopaedic specialisations. In exceptional circumstances, attendance at the workshop may be via videolink.
- The above enrolment pattern is a recommended pattern only. Students who are working whilst studying would typically complete 10-20 units per term.
