WHY STUDY WITH US?

This program is offered by the School of Architecture and Built Environment at the University of Newcastle in partnership with the South-China Agricultural University (SCAU).

This initiative came about after both institutions recognised that they have shared strengths across a number of disciplines including architecture. As a result, a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between both institutions was signed in 2017, which will now provide SCAU architecture students the opportunity to study abroad and gain entry into UON's Master of Architecture program through this valuable partnership.

On the successful completion of this program, students will graduate with a Bachelor of Engineering (Landscape Architecture) from South China Agricultural University and a Master of Architecture from The University of Newcastle.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

SCAU students in the 4 year Bachelor of Engineering (Landscape Architecture) – Cooperation Program are required to complete the first 3 years of their program. At the completion of Year 3, SCAU students who meet the following criteria will be offered direct entry into Year 1 of the Master of Architecture program at the University of Newcastle.

1. Successful completion of the first 3 years of the Bachelor of Engineering (Landscape Architecture) - Cooperation Program at SCAU
2. Average grade of 70% or higher across the first 3 years of Bachelor of Engineering (Landscape Architecture) - Cooperation Program at SCAU.
3. All applicants must demonstrate that they meet the University of Newcastle's English proficiency requirement. IELTS Overall minimum of 6.5 and IELTS section minimum of 6.0.

Students who do not meet the entry requirement above will continue into Year 4 of the Bachelor of Engineering (Landscape Architecture) at SCAU.
