



SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS

BACHELOR IN BUSINESS ANALYTICS SCHOLARSHIP

ESTABLISHMENT

The Bachelor of Business Analytics is a new program launching in 2021. The Newcastle Business School is pleased to be offering ten scholarships valued at \$5,000 each to students commencing in the Bachelor of Business Analytics program in semester 1, 2021, who attain an ATAR equivalent to 85 or above.

FUNDING ARRANGEMENT

This is a faculty funded scholarship from the Newcastle Business School.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for an offer of this scholarship, you will need to:

- Be commencing in your first year of the Bachelor of Business Analytics, University of Newcastle.
- Have achieved an Australian Tertiary Entrance Rank (ATAR) or equivalent of 85 or higher, with adjustment factors not included.
- If receiving an admission offer via Schools Recommendation Scheme (SRS), have demonstrated outstanding performance in Year 11 commensurate with a final raw ATAR of 85 or higher.
- Be enrolled full-time.
- Be enrolled on-campus with University of Newcastle.
- Not have previously completed a degree.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

As part of your application, you will need to prepare:

- No supporting documents are required for this scholarship.

SELECTION

No scholarship application is required.

Scholarships will be automatically awarded to the highest ranked candidates during the Admissions cycle from November Round 1. Preference may be given to eligible students in the November Round 1 and December Round 2 Admissions rounds.

Selection of the scholar will be based on academic merit. Student Central scholarships staff will identify potential recipients, based on the approved eligibility criteria and a review of the relevant UAC and/or University records.

Selection will be endorsed by one of the following members:

- Pro Vice-Chancellor, Faculty of Business and Law or nominee, and/or
- Heads of School, Newcastle Business School or nominee.

CONDITIONS OF AWARD

If accepting this scholarship, you agree to the following conditions:

- You will continue to meet relevant eligibility criteria (see the section titled “Eligibility” above) for the duration of the scholarship unless special consideration is approved (see below).
- You will maintain full-time enrolment in the eligible program for the duration of the scholarship.
- If your circumstances change in a way that impacts your eligibility (e.g. change in study load or withdrawal from study), you agree to notify scholarships@newcastle.edu.au.

BENEFIT

This scholarship is for a term of one year and must be taken up in the study year for which it is awarded.

The scholarship provides a total benefit of \$5000, which will be paid as \$2500 each semester after the relevant census dates (usually in April and September).

The scholarship benefit and number of scholarships awarded may vary and will be determined by the funding available each year.

PERIODS OF LEAVE

This scholarship does not support a period of leave, unless approved under special consideration provisions.

TERMINATION

Unless terminated earlier, the scholarship will end when the term has expired, and the total benefit has been paid.

Student Central Scholarships staff may terminate the scholarship before the term has expired if:

- the scholarship conditions are not met, including relevant eligibility criteria being maintained;
- the scholar completes study and/or ceases to be a student with University of Newcastle; or
- the scholar has committed serious misconduct (as determined in accordance with the University's relevant policies and rules).

If the scholarship is terminated early, the faculty funding the scholarship will be notified.

Ongoing scholarships will not be paid out in full in instances where the recipient completes study before the full scholarship term has expired.

If you have provided false or misleading information and as a result you were awarded or continued to receive the scholarship, the scholarship may be stopped, and you may be required to repay any scholarship benefits to which you are not entitled to within 14 days of being requested to do so by the University.

SPECIAL CONSIDERATION

As a scholarship recipient, if you are unable to meet the conditions of the scholarship due to illness, injury or other extenuating circumstances, you may apply for special consideration. Please apply by writing to the Scholarships Officer via email to scholarships@newcastle.edu.au. Please provide appropriate documentary evidence to support your request.

A decision will be made by Student Central Scholarships staff in consultation with the Faculty of Business and Law.
