## **Documentation required**

### **University of Newcastle students:**

### **EXTERNAL applicants:**

- END-ON HONOURS APPLICATION FORM (This form)
- DIRECT ADMISSION APPLICATION FORM
- Colour or certified 100 points of ID - This MUST include either a Birth Certificate, Passport or Citizenship Certificate
- Colour or certified official academic transcript which confirms that the award has been completed and includes a grading scale
- Evidence of English Language Proficiency if your undergraduate qualification was completed overseas
- If you are the holder of an Australian Permanent Residency Visa or Permanent Humanitarian Visa, you must provide a copy of your passport.

**External applicants also need to provide one of the following documents as evidence that their program is APAC accredited as a part of their application:**

1. An Australian Higher Education Graduation Statement (AHEGS) confirming that their undergraduate degree is APAC accredited
2. An official transcript which includes a statement confirming that their undergraduate degree is APAC accredited
3. A letter (or email) from this institution confirming that they have completed (or are currently completing) an APAC accredited undergraduate Psychology program or equivalent.

**NOTE:** Applicants with overseas undergraduate psychology qualifications need to provide a formal statement of assessment from the Australian Psychological Society (APS) to confirm the level at which their qualifications are comparable to an APAC accredited program of study in psychology.

*If applicants are currently completing their degree but will be finished prior to commencement of term, they can supply an unofficial transcript in first instance. **An official transcript including confirmation of completion will be required by 5 December 2021.***

**Offers to the Bachelor of Psychological Science (Honours) will be made from 13 December 2021.**

All applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application.
