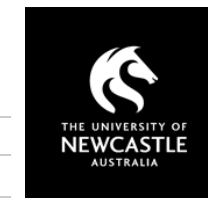

## Description

Social science provides you with the opportunity to analyse, challenge and gain an insight into theories about life cycle, gender, class, race, work, social justice and social organisation.

Social science theories are the result of systematic thinking, observations and reflection, and contribute to political and moral debate in society, rather than dictate precise answers to complex social problems.

The APAC (Australian Psychology Accreditation Council) accredited major sequence is not available to students who commence the program in 2012 or after. A Psychology major is available in the program, however it is not accredited for students commencing study in 2012 onwards. Students who commence the program in 2012 or after, and who wish to complete an accredited Psychology program, are advised to apply for admission to the 4 year Bachelor of Psychology program.

## Honours

Students who perform well during the Bachelor of Social Science program with a credit average (GPA of 5.0) or greater, may apply for a further year of full-time (or equivalent part-time) study to obtain an Honours degree. ## Additional Information

---

Psychology Major.

This major is for students with a general interest in Psychology, and for those who see Psychology as complementary to their studies in Social Science. It is not accredited by the Australian Psychology Accreditation Council (APAC).

All students can access additional learning development mechanisms provided by the Centre for Teaching and Learning.

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students can draw on the assistance and support provided by the Indigenous Student Support and Development service through the Wollotuka Institute.

## Requirements and Structure

---

In order to qualify for the Bachelor of Social Science award, a student must successfully complete 240 units comprising of:

- CORE COURSES - 80 units of core courses;
- ONE MAJOR - 80 units of an Approved Social Science major; of which no more than 20 units should be at least 1000 level, and at least 40 units at 3000 level;
- ELECTIVES - 80 units. 40 units of these electives must be approved social science courses (an approved social science course is any course listed in the Bachelor of Social Science program handbook). The remaining 40 units of electives can be chosen from any non-restricted courses offered by the University.

A student may count a maximum of 100 units at 1000 level.

Full-time enrolment (80 units per year) will enable program completion in three years. Students may enrol in less than 80 units per year and completion will take proportionately longer.

Students should complete the prescribed sequence of core courses in the specified order to satisfy the requirements, as they involve the progressive acquisition of knowledge and skills.

Please refer to the Program Enrolment Checklists (PECs) in the Further Information section at the top of this page. These PECs will assist you in understanding the requirements and structure of your program and will assist with your enrolment.

## Transition Arrangements

---

An APAC (Australian Psychology Accreditation Council) accredited Psychology Major is not available to students who commenced the degree from 2012 or after.

Students who commenced the program prior to 2012, and who are undertaking a 120 unit APAC approved sequence of courses in Psychology followed by an accredited fourth year, will be able to complete the accredited sequence, but must complete the program within a limited number of years. Students should seek independent advice from the School of Psychology and relevant Program Officer regarding their eligibility for accreditation.

Any student who completed SOCA1160 at Ourimbah prior to 2011 will be able to count SOCA1160 in place of SOCA1010.

Students who commenced the Aboriginal Studies or the Philosophical and Religious Studies Majors prior to 2011 will be able to count courses that were listed as part of the major to their program.

Students who commenced a major before it was deleted are permitted to continue with that major by enrolling in designated courses still on offer (available in other majors) or by requesting permission to substitute courses to make up the major requirements if not enough courses are on offer.

The Australia Asia-Pacific Studies Major has been discontinued from 2008 onwards. Courses remain available under other majors such as Aboriginal Studies, History, Sociology & Anthropology. Students majoring in Australia Asia-Pacific Studies (prior to 2008) will be able to complete their major from the listed courses and should consult with the Student Hub if they have any questions.
