- ✓ Core courses - 390 units.

- ✓ This program involves clinical placements which have [specific requirements](#), including NSW Health Verification.
- ✓ Students may apply for a further year of full time study (taken after the completion of Year 3) to obtain an Honours degree.
- ✓ The duration of this program is 5 years full time study (students must undertake 40 units per semester).
- ✓ The maximum time to complete this program is 8 years.
