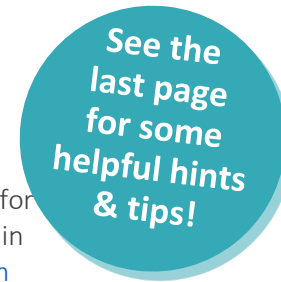

To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 320 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Core courses – 170 units. **Note:** Core courses COMP3851A and COMP3851B (20 units) also count towards the Enterprise Information Technology Major.
- ✓ COMP3851A and COMP3851B must be taken in sequence, within the same year of study.
- ✓ Enterprise Information Technology Major – 40 units, comprised of 30 units of compulsory courses and 10 units of directed courses.
- ✓ Bachelor of Business Major – 70 units. Select one of the following majors:
  - International Business - 40 units of compulsory courses and 30 units of directed courses.
  - Leadership and Management - 30 units of compulsory courses and 40 units of directed courses.
- ✓ B Information Technology Directed courses – 10 units.
- ✓ Electives – 30 units. Visit the [Course Handbook](#) to see a list of available Electives.
- ✓ The duration of this program is 4 years full time study (40 units per semester) or part time equivalent.
- ✓ The maximum time to complete this program is 10 years.
