EARTHQUAKE

| • KEEP AWAY FROM windows, mirrors and overhead fittings | • DO NOT use machines, lights, open flame appliances, lighters or matches, or electrical equipment when gas or fuel leaks are suspected |
| • TAKE COVER beside a solid object such as a door-frame, table or bench and not in the middle of a room | • DO NOT use the telephone unless there is a SERIOUS INJURY OR RISK |
| • KEEP WELL CLEAR of buildings, power lines, trees if outside. | • AVOID driving (keep roadways clear for emergency vehicles) |
| • DO NOT stand under awnings or parapets as they may collapse | • BE PREPARED for after-shocks |
| • MOVE to open ground when the shaking reduces | |

FLOOD AND STORM SURGE

- Move to higher ground and follow any instructions of State Emergency Services (SES), Police, or Security Services
- Do not attempt to drive or walk through water of unknown depth
- Listen for flood advice from SES or Campus Administration if access to the campus is likely to be affected
- ABC Radio (1233 on the AM band) will give advice about the situation and forecasts

FIRE

- DO NOT USE LIFTS
- NO SMOKING must be observed during any evacuation procedure
- EXIT THE BUILDING AND FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS OF EVACUATION WARDEN(S)

GAS EMERGENCY or CHEMICAL SPILLS or RADIATION SPILLS

Remain upwind of the incident scene – if possible without risk of injury or illness, identify the substance involved, and report to Emergency Services upon their arrival.

Isolate the immediate area. Limit the spread of liquids by using absorbent materials.

BOMB THREAT

REFER TO QUESTIONS IN THE EMERGENCY FLIP CHARTS.

CALMLY EVACUATE THE BUILDING IN AN ORDERLY MANNER

FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS OF SECURITY SERVICES, EMERGENCY WARDENS AND EMERGENCY SERVICES
