FUND A PHD SCHOLARSHIP OVER 3.5 YEARS: \$103,000

Every year we receive a large number of applications for PhD Scholarships. Unfortunately, the Government and the University can only fund a number of scholarships each year. This means that many potential research students are unable to start their chosen research. Scholarships are paid to our research students as a living allowance stipend over 3.5 years, giving them the security they need to cover living expenses, while they concentrate fully on their research and the next new breakthrough.

FUND A PHD TOP-UP SCHOLARSHIP: \$5,000 TO \$20,000 ANNUALLY FOR 3.5 YEARS

Attracting top research students to the Hunter can be a challenge, especially in a competitive environment where other universities are actively recruiting promising research students.

The standard research scholarship stipend pays research students approximately \$29,000 a year, which can be difficult to live on. To make things easier, PhD Top-up Scholarships of \$5,000, \$10,000, \$15,000 or \$20,000 can be

offered to top research students as an incentive to stay and continue their work at the University of Newcastle. It also means they can cut back on their other (out of business-hours) paid work commitments to concentrate entirely on their research. If you are interested in supporting quality research in the Hunter you can opt to set up a PhD Top-up Scholarship.

DONATE TOWARDS OUR RESEARCH AND DISCOVERY FUND: \$2+

You might not be in a position to set up a full scholarship, but you can still make an impact. The University has a dedicated Research and Discovery fund where you can donate \$100, \$500, \$1,000 or indeed any amount over \$2. These donations towards research are tax deductible.

The Research and Discovery Fund could be used in a variety of ways, including support for researchers with conference and travel scholarships, PhD Top-up Scholarships, research equipment and early career fellowships.
