
APPLICATION FOR CONCURRENT ENROLMENT

- Joint Medical Program (obviously not available to add as a concurrent enrolment anyway)

You can apply for these programs through the <u>Universities Admission Centre</u> (UAC). **Note:** external application deadline may apply.

- meet the admission requirements for the second program you are proposing to undertake.
