INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS WHO COMMENCED PRIOR TO 2019.

The following tables display the approved transition arrangements for students who commenced in the Visual Arts major in the B Education (Secondary) program or B Education (Secondary) (Honours) in 2018.

Effective Semester 1 2019, some AART courses have undergone a name change and some AART course have changed course levels. Directed Courses AART2260 and AART2270 have been removed from the major and there are changes to the Directed Course lists.

- *Directed Course B - 2D Principle Studio* is now *Directed Course B - 2D Visual Art*.
- Courses previously listed in the *Directed B Courses - Photo Studio* are incorporated into the *Directed Course B - 2D Visual Art* list.
- *Directed Course B - 3D Principle Studio* is now *Directed C Courses - 3D/4D Visual Art* with additional choice in Animation and Media Production courses.

The Visual Arts extended studies does not lead to students qualifying with an additional teaching area.

Courses completed pre-2019 will count towards the 2019 major requirements.

Students are to complete the 2019 course if you have not already successfully completed the equivalent course in 2018 or prior.
