Frequently Asked Questions

Does this change what I need to enrol in?

No. You still need to complete 20 units of core courses, a 10 unit Group A directed course, and a 10 unit Group B directed course. If you have completed a Group A directed course or Group B directed course that is no longer offered, it will still count towards your program.

Can I still complete my program?

Yes, you will still be able to complete your program.

Will this delay my graduation?

No. As the changes do not increase the total number of courses you need to complete, these changes will not delay your graduation.

Can I complete one of the new courses?

You can only complete ENV56510 if you have not yet completed your Group A directed course. You can only complete PSYC6120 or PSYC6130 if you have not yet completed your Group B directed course.

I have completed a course that is no longer offered, will it still count towards my program?

If you have completed a Group A directed course or Group B directed course that is no longer offered, it will still count towards your program.

Is the Master of Environmental and Business Management still available?

From 2021 the Master of Environmental and Business Management will no longer be offered to new students and will be replaced by an updated Master of Environmental Management and Sustainability. Students who intended to complete the Master of Environmental and Business Management should consider applying for the Master of Environmental Management and Sustainability program instead.
