Frequently Asked Questions

Does this change what I need to enrol in?

The courses you need to enrol in may have changed, however you will not be required to complete more than the 160 units required for your program.

Will this delay my graduation?

No. As the changes do not increase the total number of courses you need to complete, these changes will not delay your graduation.

I have completed one of the discontinued courses, will this count towards my degree?

Yes, any courses completed that have been discontinued still count towards your program requirements.
