INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS WHO COMMENCED IN THE BACHELOR OF ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE AND MANAGEMENT/BACHELOR OF BUSINESS [40172] PRIOR TO 2023

The University is incorporating Work Integrated Learning (WIL) into all undergraduate programs as a 10-unit Core Course (ENVS3008 – Work Integrated Learning in the Environmental and Development Sectors), for students commencing in the program from 2023 onwards. WIL provides students from all disciplines and backgrounds with the opportunity to gain real world work experience and improve employability outcomes. ENVS3008 has been revised to increase the placement hours from 80 to 140 hours for students commencing in the program from 2023 onwards.

Transition Arrangements

Pre-2023 students who have not successfully completed either ENVS3008 (current 80-hour iteration) or GEO3250, will need to complete placement course **ENVS3008 – Work Integrated Learning in the Environmental and Development Sectors** (140-hour iteration), as part of their degree.

Students who need to complete a further 10-unit 3000 level Directed course (as part of their major) may wish to complete GEOS3250 to fulfill this requirement.
