Frequently Asked Questions

Does this change what I need to enrol in?

The courses you need to enrol in will have changed only if you have completed SCIE1001, however you will not be required to complete more than the 240 units required for your program.

Will this delay my graduation?

No. As the changes do not increase the total number of courses you need to complete, these changes will not delay your graduation.

I have completed SCIE1001 will this count towards my degree?

Yes, if you have completed SCIE1001 it still counts towards your program. You will need to enrol in SCIE2003 and a 10 unit elective instead of SCIE2002 and SCIE2004.

I have completed SCIE2002 and/or SCIE2004 what should I enrol in?

There are no students who commenced the Bachelor of Psychological Science (Advanced) in 2020 who have completed, or are enrolled in SCIE2002 or SCIE2004.
